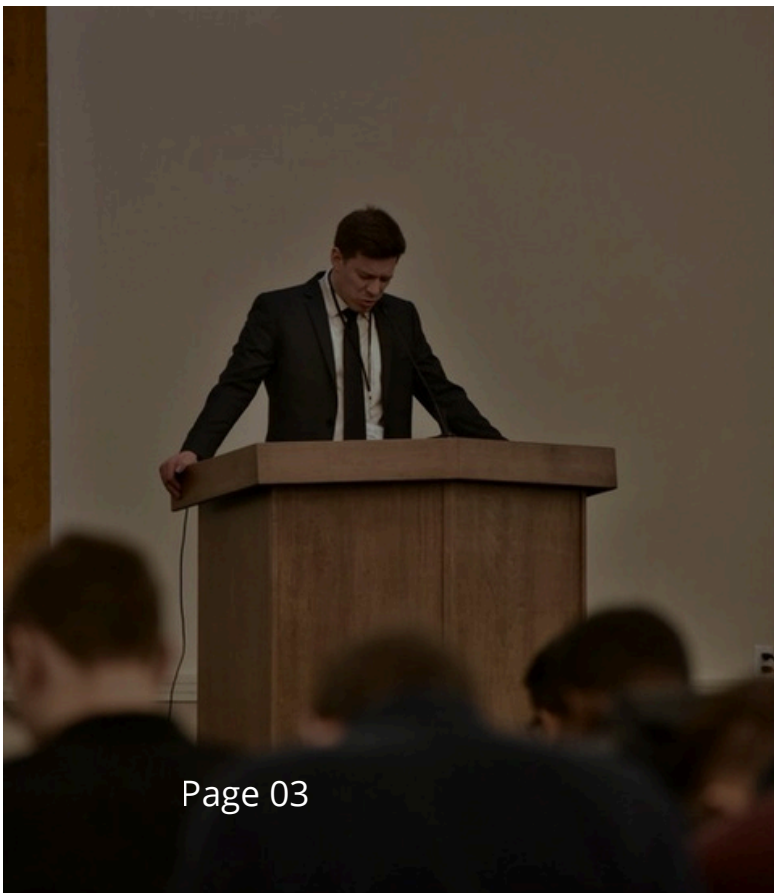
# We are just two weeks away!

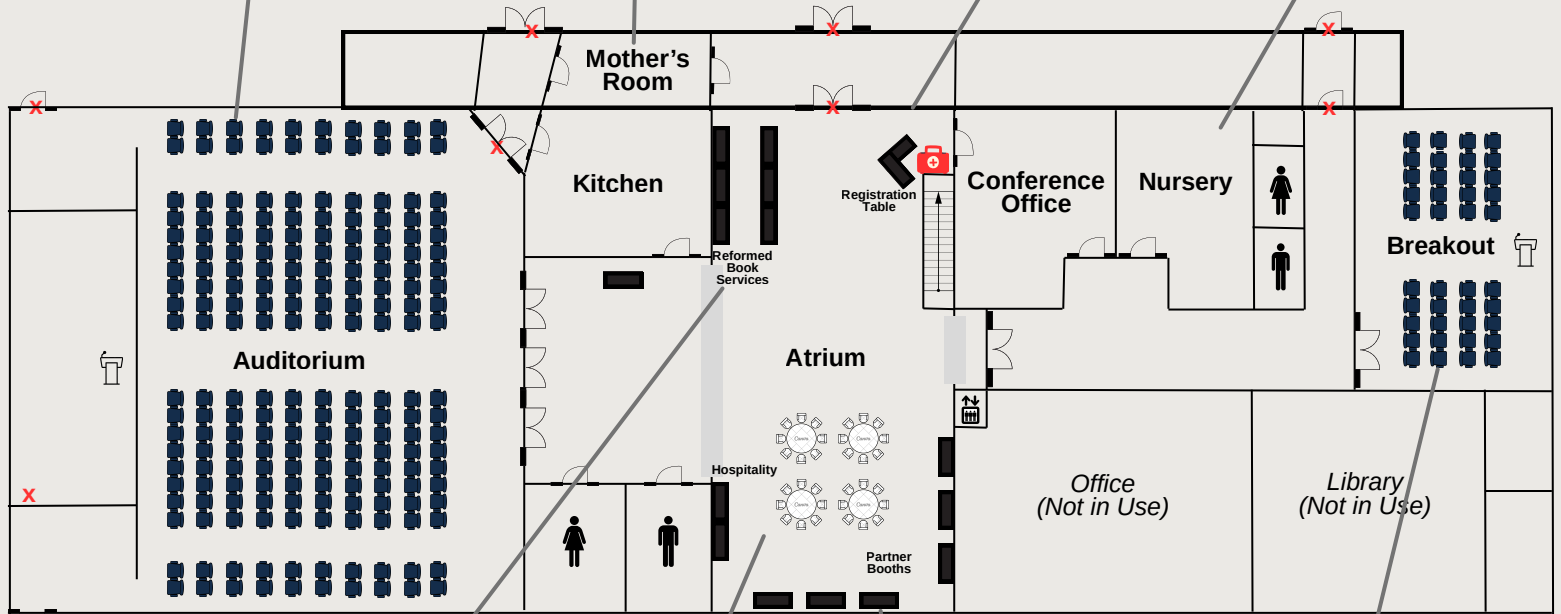

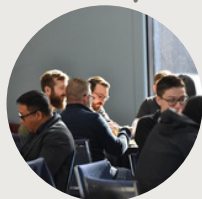

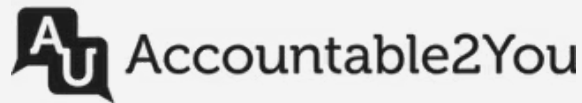
