The 'Every Book of the Bible' memory plan is intended to help you memorize the books of the Old and New Testaments in order, along with 1-3 verses in each book. These memory verses often summarize the theme or serve as pivotal texts in the selected book.

Bible Book	Reference	Memory Verse(s)
Matthew	Matthew 28:18-20	<sup>18</sup> And Jesus came and said to them, “All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. <sup>19</sup> Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, <sup>20</sup> teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age.”
Mark	Mark 10:45	<sup>45</sup> For even the Son of Man came not to be served but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many.”
Luke	Luke 4:18-19	<sup>18</sup> “The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he has anointed me to proclaim good news to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim liberty to the captives and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty those who are oppressed, <sup>19</sup> to proclaim the year of the Lord’s favor.”
John	John 1:11-13	<sup>11</sup> He came to his own, and his own people did not receive him. <sup>12</sup> But to all who did receive him, who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God, <sup>13</sup> who were born, not of blood nor of the will of the flesh nor of the will of man, but of God.
Acts	Acts 16:30-31	<sup>30</sup> Then he brought them out and said, “Sirs, what must I do to be saved?” <sup>31</sup> And they said, “Believe in the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved, you and your household.”

Romans	Romans 8:31-33	<sup>31</sup> What then shall we say to these things? If God is for us, who can be against us? <sup>32</sup> He who did not spare his own Son but gave him up for us all, how will he not also with him graciously give us all things? <sup>33</sup> Who shall bring any charge against God's elect? It is God who justifies.
1 Corinthians	1 Corinthians 10:31	<sup>31</sup> So, whether you eat or drink, or whatever you do, do all to the glory of God.
2 Corinthians	2 Corinthians 5:21	<sup>21</sup> For our sake he made him to be sin who knew no sin, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God.
Galatians	Galatians 2:20	<sup>20</sup> I have been crucified with Christ. It is no longer I who live, but Christ who lives in me. And the life I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me.
Ephesians	Ephesians 2:8-9	<sup>8</sup> For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, <sup>9</sup> not a result of works, so that no one may boast.
